**PRESS RELEASE**

**From Your Pulaski County Sheriff's Department**

**June 4, 2008**

On June 4, 2008 the Pulaski County Sheriff's Department arrested a Bronston man for being a Fugitive From Another State. The fugitive was wanted by the Wise County, Virginia Sheriff's Department for Failure to Appear in Wise County Court on felony charges.

The suspect, **Keith Taylor**, age 34, of 115 Rolling Cliff Drive Bronston, Kentucky, had been arrested on June 3, 2008 by Detectives of the Pulaski County Sheriff's Department on Jacksboro Road Bronston, Kentucky for Trafficking In A Controlled Substance.

When **Taylor** was fingerprinted by the Pulaski County Detention Center on the Automated Fingerprint Identification System a hit confirmation was received from the State of Virginia revealing that **Taylor** was a wanted fugitive.

The Automated Fingerprint Identification System automatically sends the scanned fingerprints to the Kentucky State Police AFIS System in Frankfort, Kentucky which searches their files for a match then the scanned fingerprints are automatically sent to the National Crime Information Center for a search on a national level. The search, which takes only a short period of time, resulted in **Taylor** being identified as a wanted fugitive.

Sheriff Wood stated the Automated Fingerprint Identification System, such as the one installed at the Pulaski County Detention Center is a valuable tool in law enforcement endeavor to identify and apprehend fugitives who might otherwise go undetected.
